Manipulatives (manipulatives are relevant for all ages and stages)

An Atlas (locating continents, countries, oceans, capital cities, flags)

A Globe (locating, countries, oceans, lines of longitude and latitude, bordering countries)

Map of the World (locating world's continents and countries, comparing land size of different countries)

Map of the U.K. (become familiar with main cities of the U.K. and where they are located)

Map of Europe (become familiar with the main countries near to the U.K. and where they are located. Try to locate some of the main cities in countries nearby that could be popular holiday destinations or city breaks e.g. Madrid and Barcelona in Spain)

Look at the seas around Europe; e.g. Mediterranean Sea and Baltic Sea, and which countries they are near to.

These will be some of the main holiday port destinations along their coast where cruise ships might dock. Try to find some that may be near to a city further inland e.g. Rome in Italy.
